BRITISH COLUMBIA JUNIOR HOCKEY LEAGUE HISTORY

The 1988-89 season represents the 27th year of existence for the B.C. Junior Hockey League.

Canada's most westerly Junior A hockey circuit had a somewhat innocuous beginning that season of 1961-62 with just four clubs taking to the ice. Ironically, three of those four teams remain intact today, including Vernon, Kelowna and Penticton. Only Kamloops, the fourth original club, has since left the fold for the much larger scope of the major junior Western Hockey League.

Nobody could envision 27 years ago exactly what the league would look like this far down the road and certainly none of those original four teams expected to be the nucleus of such a highly successful sports league such as the BCJHL is today.

Those three Okanagan Valley teams that survived the founding season, now constitute one half of the Interior Division of the BCJHL. The other three, Merritt, Salmon Arm, and Summerland, currently taking a year's leave of absence, round out the interior roster.

The Coastal Division, which was added to the league in the 1973-74 season, is currently comprised of teams located in Nanaimo and Juan De Fuca, Richmond, Chilliwack, New Westminster, and the latest addition in Powell River. The latter moved from Delta during the summer of 1988.

Throughout the 27-year history of the league, the three Okanagan teams have anchored the league while franchises have changed hands in both divisions. In fact, few major centres in the Lower Mainland or the southern and central interior of the province have not supported a league franchise for at least a season or two.

The fact remains, however, that the league has grown and prospered during its lifetime, even outliving and absorbing the now-defunct Pacific Junior Hockey League which was formed in 1973 and ceased to exist after the 1979-80 season. In the interim, a team from Gx Bellingham, Wash. left the Pac "A" loop to join the BCJHL making this league an international sports organization for a few brief seasons.

Although success on a national scale was slow in coming to the BCJHL, it finally arrived during the decade of the 1980s and during this time the BCJHL has proved to be one of the most consistent junior A leagues in the country at driving for a national title. The highlight of this decade were the back-to-back Centennial Cup Championships shared by the Penticton Knights in 1985 and the Richmond Sockeyes in 1987.

Both Penticton and the Abbotsford Flyers made an appearance in the national championship final during this decade as well.

The BCJHL has proven itself to be a hotbed of hockey talent over the three decades of its existence, supplying both players and coaches to higher calibre competition.

The main function of the league now is to provide talent for the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA). This is another area which has been tapped and exploited during the decade of the 1980s. More and more NCAA clubs find that talented players from the BCJHL make some of the steadiest and most reliable collegiate performers, carrying their work ethics and hard-nosed attitudes into the realm of college hockey once they leave the BCJHL. It is this tradition, more than any other, that the league now strives to maintain.

The Vernon Lakers will become the first BCJHL team in league history to host the Centennial Cup when they entertain the nation's best Junior A clubs in 1990. By then the league will have finished its 30th year of operation.

Another Centennial Cup title at that time would make a fitting anniversary gift.

The Six Men on A Hockey Team



GOALKEEPER — The goalkeeper's main responsibility is to keep the puck from entering the goal and there are no restrictions placed on the methods he can employ. His offensive contributions are limited and consist of occasionally passing the puck up to his defensemen or forwards to start a rush. A goalkeeper never scores a goal and only on rare occasions does he receive credit for an assist.

DEFENSEMEN — Basically the two defensemen try to stop the incoming play at their own blue line. They also block shots, clear the puck from in front of their goal and watch the opposing forwards. Offensively they carry the puck up the ice or pass the puck up to the forwards, then follow the play into the attacking zone and help to keep it there.

CENTER — The center operates mostly up and down the middle of the ice and usually leads his team's attack by carrying the puck. He sets up plays by exchanging passes with his two wingmen and tries to steer the play in towards the opponent's goal. Defensively he tries to keep the play in the attacking zone by harassing the puck carrier. (Forechecking) After the opposition works the puck out of their end of the rink, he tries to interrupt their playmaking as it moves through the neutral zone and into his defending zone (backchecking).

WINGS — The two wings move up and down the sides of the rink with the direction of play. Offensively they skate abreast of the center exchanging passes with him while positioning themselves for a shot on the goal. Defensively they watch their playmaking and shooting as the action moves back towards the defending zone. (Backchecking)

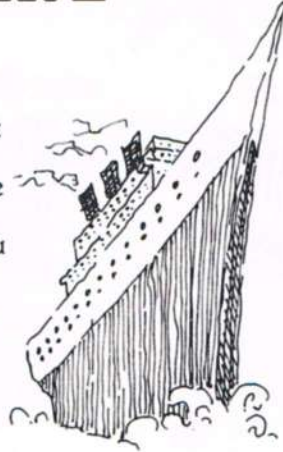
