Manager Howie Sugden told The Vernon News Wednesday the tickets would be priced at \$5.25 and good for 15 home games.

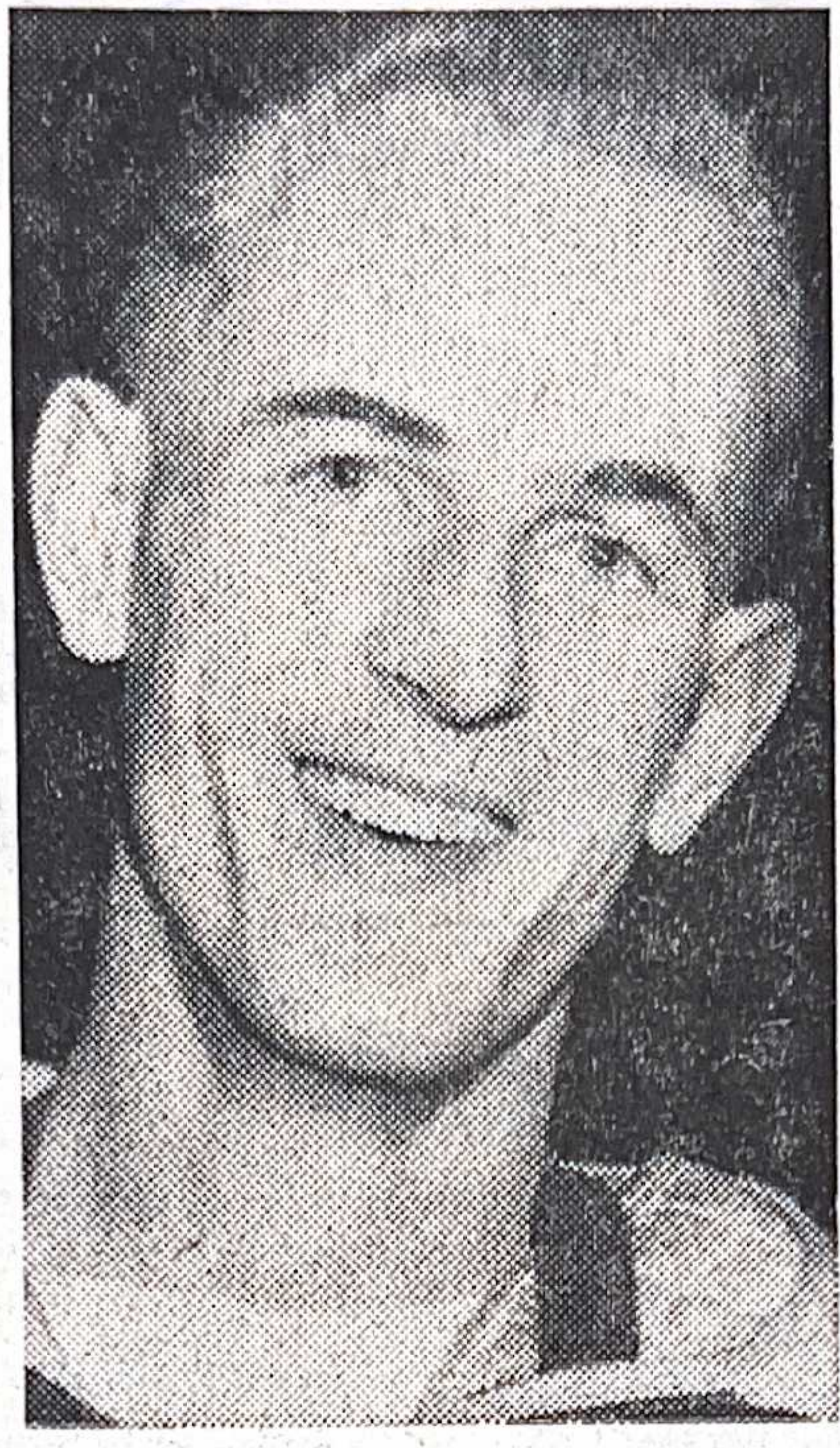
"We've not incurred any debts so far, but anticipate a few bills as the season goes on. With the money from these tickets we can pay as we go," he said.

Beck in a letter to Vernon Minor Hockey Association president Bill Brown Friday, said he was now playing junior "B" hockey in Flin Flon, and would rather play with the newly-formed Vernon club in the Okanagan Junior "A" Hockey League.

Brown was angry at the shoddy way in which Beck was treated during his stay in Flin Flon. "They took him out there to play junior "A" hockey and it was only for that reason we let him go."

"My only correspondence with Flin Flon on the matter was a brief wire from manager George Allard requesting his release. I told him to go through the proper channels, but his card still belongs to us, so he can play here if he likes," said Brown.

Beck is expected back in time for Tuesday night's league opener against Kelowna Buckaroos.
