

# Blades Ice 3 Revamped Front Lines

The Vernon Blades will be trying three new attack formations when they step on the ice against the Kelowna Buckaroos here Friday night.

Coach Bill Brown has rearranged his forward lines and worked them out hard this week in an effort to get some consistent scoring power.

On the first string Buck Sherk will team up with Howie McNeil and Jim Stephen, Bobby Stein will work with Gordie Kineshanko and Ralph Litzenberger, and for the third line Corky Agar will take a wing spot alongside Ike Coulter and Dale Sorochnik.

Brown figures this will distribute the weight around more evenly and so balance the club's whole attack.

The Blades' coach also expects to have Gary Roland of Lumby out for the weekend junior hockey action.
