

Blades winners

Vernon Blades handed the Kamloops Kraft Kings their 30th loss of the season last night by beating them 7-3 at Civic Arena.

The game, which had Vernon leading 1-0 in the first period on Lawrence Quechuck's goal, was tied 2-2 after two periods. But a 5-1 goal outburst by Blades in the third session wrapped it up.

Vernon scoring was shared among seven different players and all but two of them reached the score-sheet in one way or another. Keith Rolston scored the only Vernon marker in the second period while Kamloops' three goals were shared by Gerry Janicki, with two, and Bob Law, with the other.

Other Vernon scorers were Tom Williamson, Ken Pollen, Ivan Malinosky, Tom Serviss and Mike Perepolkin.

The victory gave Blades 13 wins against 24 losses on the season but they are still assured of nothing

more than a third place finish.

Tomorrow night they travel to Kelowna for a game with the second place Buckaroos and do not open in Civic Arena again until a week from Saturday when they play host to the pennant winning Penticton Broncos in the final match of the regular league schedule.
