

# Showstopper Hull stumped!



KELOWNA — Bobby Hull went scoreless Saturday night and his Red team lost for the first time in the three years he has been taking part in the annual Midsummer Hockey Game, which kicked off the week-long Kelowna Regatta at the weekend.

Hull claimed two assists however, as the White team coached by Don Culley of the OJHL Kelowna Buckaroos swept aside Penticton Bronco mentor Jack Taggart's Red squad 6-3.

Veteran Art Jones of the WHL Portland Buckaroos scored twice near the 10 minute mark of the first period giving Whites their first lead, 2-1. but Guyle Fielder of the Seattle Totems, who was set up by a Hull pass to open the scoring for Reds after only 20 seconds into the game, knotted the score at 2-2 before the end of the session.

Whites got goals from Arnie Schmautz (Portland) and Bill (Red) Hay (Chicago Black Hawks) in the second period, and led 4-2 after the sandwich session.

Bruce Carmichael (Vancouver Canucks) narrowed the gap to 4-3 early in the finale but John Strong (Kelowna Buckaroos) and Hay, with his second marker of the evening, pulled the game out of reach just past the mid-way point in the stanza.

Jack Bionda (Portland), former lacrosse star and present WHL bad man, playing for the White unit, was chased on the only two penalties of the game.

The spectacle was highlighted in the third period when colorful Eddie Shack (formerly of the Toronto Maple Leafs) returned to the game for the second year in a row to share the limelight with Hull, was presented with a cow.

Tom Williamson and Tom Serviss of Vernon Blades teamed with Brian Fisher of Kelowna on the White squad, with Serviss faced with the task of shadowing Hull at various times during the game.
