

The *Eagles* are coming

The Salt Lake City Eagles have selected Vernon as the site of their first training camp. The new entry into the Pacific Coast Hockey League's intentions were announced at the Vernon Recreation Commission meeting Tuesday night.

The team will hold the first week of its camp in Kelowna from the 14 to 19 of September then will move to Vernon for the week of September 20 to 27.

As well as holding their training camp in the Vernon Civic Arena, the Eagles will host an exhibition game in Vernon at the end of the session.

The Commission members expressed a great

amount of delight at having Vernon chosen as the spot for the Eagles camp. One of the happiest men on the Commission is Vern Dye who will be running the Vernon Esso Junior hockey training camp at the same time.

The Eagles will use the facilities of the arena during the daytime, while the Juniors will take to the ice at night for their work-outs.

The Commission voted unanimously to inform the Salt Lake City club that the ice will be available to them on the requested dates.

In other business arising from the arena, the commission was informed

that the new ice-resurfacer is the primary expense that will be undertaken in the very near future.

Facilities manager John Bruce stated that a telegram had been received from the Zamboni corporation saying that the full particulars on the machine best suited to the Vernon arena were on the way and would be in the hands of the commission within a very few days.
