

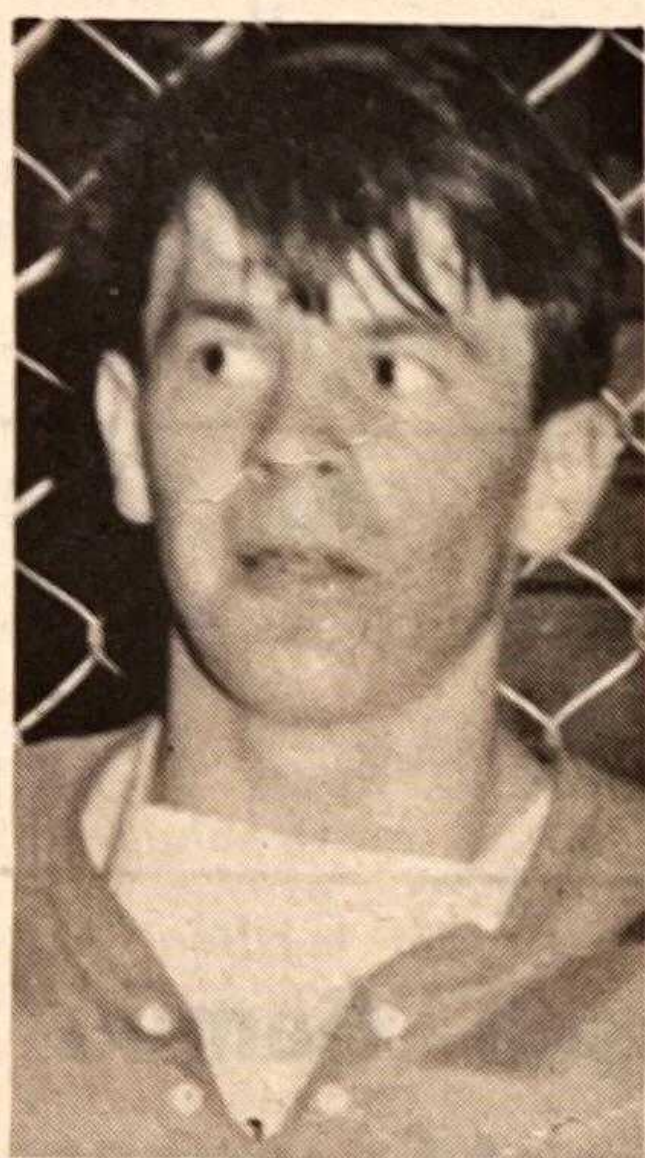
Training starts Friday
