# Junior finals to start here Saturday

B.C. Junior A hockey finals involving Vernon Essos and as yet the unknown winner of the semi-final series between Penticton and Kamloops has been re-scheduled from this Friday night here at Civic Arena to Saturday night.

Word of the change came early today as Essos manager Vern Dye told The News he had been informed by the league the change had been made because of ice time problems at

Kamloops holding up the semi-final playoffs.

At the present time, Penticton Broncos hold a 3-2 edge in victories over the Kamloops Rockets by virtue of their latest one-sided win Tuesday night on home ice when they thumped the Rockets 7-0.

Next game of this series goes back to Kamloops Thursday night and if a seventh encounter is needed will be back in Penticton Friday night.

While both teams have taken advantage of home ice, Penticton taking three wins now by 3-1, 3-1 and 7-0 scores and Kamloops edging the Broncos 5-1 and 5-2 on their ice, the series could end Thursday at Kamloops if the final score Tuesday was any indication. As can be noted, should a seventh game be necessary, Penticton would have the advantage of their home environment.

Meanwhile at Vernon, Essos are skating daily but are taking it easy as they rest for the big best of seven final.

Game time this Saturday has been set for an 8 p.m. start.
