Chilliwack Bruins were handed their sixth straight defeat Sunday night as Vernon Vikings took their sixth straight win with a 7-3 decision in British Columbia Junior Hockey League play in Vernon.

Seven players handled the Vernon scoring, with Ron Murdoch, Tad Campbell, Dave Dubbin, Ken Price, Ron Arishenkoff, Bob MacGillevray and Martin Stein the goalgetters.

Rick Durstan had two goals and Brian Didier had one for Chilliwack.
