## Three victories in as many tries

Scoring was wide open Friday night in the British Columbia Junior Hockey League as Kelowna Buckaroos smashed Nanaimo Clippers 9-3, Vernon Vikings beat Chilliwack Bruins 5-2 and Penticton Broncos walked over Langley Lords 4-1.

In Langley, the Broncos broke the Lords' 12-game home winning streak. Mark Sevryn led Penticton with two goals. Pat Sevryn and Kirk Aulin rounded out the visiting team's scoring. Barry Beck scored for Langley.

The Broncos led 2-0 at the end of the first period and 4-0 after 40 minutes.

In Nanaimo, Dwayne Monteth's three goals helped the Buckaroos regain first place in the league's Interior division.

Dale Costanzo scored two more while Mark Lofthouse, Brad Owens, Murray Hanson and Dave Fleming scored singles.

Gordon Dumont tallied twice for the Clippers while Alan Hill got the other Nanaimo goal.

Kelowna held a 3-1 first-period lead and led 6-2 going into the third period.

In Chilliwack, Dave Caldwell, Greg Howe, Rod Bick, Don Murdoch and Marty Stein scored for the triumphant Vikings while Gary Huth and Dave Sharples counted for the Bruins.

In league action tonight, Penticton travels to Merritt to play the Centennials, Nanaimo hosts Vernon and Kelowna travels to Chilliwack.
