

# BCJHL organizes 'Shootout'

The B.C. Junior Hockey League has announced it will conduct a competition based on, "Showdown in the NHL," during the 1974-75 season.

League Executive Director Bryan Couling says the contest will be held at every league game, immediately prior to the first period.

Couling says each team will be allowed to select two shooters, who will take one shot each at the opposition goalie, for a total of four shots in each game.

Couling said, "we feel there's nothing in hockey more exciting than a breakaway or a penalty shot. Now we're giving our fans at least four of them every time they go to a BCJHL game."

The league will call the new competition "Shootout."

Full statistical records will be kept, with awards being presented at the end of the regular season.
