

# Henderson earns his first shutout

Netminder Brian Henderson earned his first shutout of the British Columbia Junior Hockey League season Wednesday as Langley Lords blanked Chilliwack Bruins 3-0.

In Penticton, the Broncos grabbed a 3-1 lead in the opening period en route to a 7-3 victory over Kelowna Buckaroos.

The win tightened the Broncos grip on second place in the interior division. They have 33 points, 15 behind the Buckaroos. In the coast division, the Lords moved three points ahead of second-place Chilliwack. Langley has 33 points.

Goalie Henderson turned aside 28 shots, including 11 in the third period. Gary Scott blocked 24 shots in the Chilliwack net.

Penticton led 5-3 after the second period.

Del Iannone paced the Broncos with a pair of goals. Mark Patterson, Kirk Aulin, Bob Irvine, Greg Milliard and Pat Severyn picked up singles.

Doug Davis scored twice for Kelowna while Archie McKinnon scored once.

Tonight Nanaimo travels to Merritt and Chilliwack hosts Bellingham.
