Broncos edge Bucks on overtime goal

PENTICTON, B.C. (CP) — Gord MacKay scored at 5:11 of sudden-death overtime to give Penticton Broncos a 6-5 win over Kelowna Buckaroos in a British Columbia Junior Hockey League game Friday.

Kelowna forced the game into overtime when they pulled their goalie and evened the score at 5-5 with only eight seconds left in regulation time.

Pat Severyn and Bob Irvine each scored twice for Penticton while Jerry Thygessos added a single.

Bill Haynes scored for Kelowna to send the game into overtime. Archie McKinnon, Gord Gibson, Mark Schnarr and Gene Weninger scored earlier.

Kelowna led 2-1 at the end of the first period but Penticton came back to lead 4-3 after two.

Kelowna outshot Penticton 40-36 and each team picked up nine minors and one major in front of a crowd of 1,000.

The win puts Penticton into second place in the interior division, one point ahead of Vernon. The two second-place
