

DELIVER A 13-6 KNOCKOUT

Bucks smash Vikings

Kelowna Buckaroos blasted Vernon Vikings 13-6 Friday to take a 24-point lead over second-place Penticton Broncos in the Interior Division of the British Columbia Junior Hockey League.

In other BCJHL action, Langley Lords dumped Nanaimo Clippers 9-3 in Langley and Chilliwack Bruins beat Bellingham Blazers 3-1.

Archie McKinnon and Perry Schnarr gave the Buckaroos

four-goal performances as Kelowna led 6-2 after the first period and 9-4 after the second.

Doug Berry, with two, Gord Dumont, Gene Weninger and Mark Schnarr completed the Buckaroos' scoring.

Dwight Bailey led Vernon with two goals. Jack Lefley, Gary Gilchrist, Pete Poeschek and Ron Areshnekoff scored singles for the Vikings.

Kelowna now has 70 points in the Interior Division.

Vernon, with 44, is two behind secondplace Penticton. Merritt, in the cellar, has 36.

In the Coast Division, Langley and Bellingham are tied for first place—both have 47 points. Chilliwack has three less and Nanaimo is at the bottom with 28 points.

In Langley, Terry Tarnow scored once each in the first and third periods and twice in the second to lead the Lords to victory.

The Lords led 2-0 after the first period then took a 7-2 lead

going into the third.

Randy Weins, Lane Lavik, Ryan Walter, Sandy Bain and Kelly Ferner scored the other Langley goals.

Dale Ewasiuk, Jim Slater and Bob Burgoyne scored for the Clippers.

In Chilliwack, the Bruins were stalled at 1-1 until the end of the second period.

Scoring for the Bruins were Morley Anderson, Carl Cureatz and Vern Quaroni. Bellingham's only goal came from Stan Smyl.
