## Vikings now trail Broncos by four

Penticton Broncos moved four points ahead of Vernon Vikings in the battle for second-place in the interior division of the B.C. Junior Hockey League with a 9-6 win over Merritt Centennials Tuesday.

Broncos now have 50 points, Vernon 46, and last-place Merritt has 36 points. Kelowna Buckaroos lead the interior division with 74 points.

goals while Del Iannone added two. Bryan James had a single.

Greg Agar and Darrell Zelinski scored two goals each for Merritt while Dan Rota and Warren Terry notched one apiece.
