

Langley Lords go down 11-8 after hard fight

Langley Lords fought back from a 7-3 second-period deficit only to lose 11-8 to Kelowna Buckaroos Friday night in British Columbia Junior Hockey League action.

In the only other game, Nanaimo Clippers slashed Chilliwack Bruins 8-2 in Chilliwack.

Kelowna's home win gave the Bucks 84 points in the interior division top spot, 18 more than second-place Penticton Broncos. In the coast division, Nanaimo is still in the cellar with 40 points, 18 back of third-place Chilliwack. Langley and Bellingham are tied in first place in the coast with 61 points.

Langley led 2-0 early in the first period before Kelowna scored three unanswered goals to lead 3-2 going into the second frame. Langley tied it 3-3 28 seconds into the middle period before Kelowna

pumped in four quick goals.

The Lords fought back and tied it again at 8-8 at the end of 40 minutes.

Brian Henderson scored five goals to lead the valiant Langley attack while Sandy Bain added two and Tom Williamson had a single for the Lords.

Kelowna's Doug Berry had three goals and two assists to regain the top position in the league scoring race with a total of 128 points. Penticton's Del Iannone has 125 points in second position.

Perry Schnarr, Mark Schnarr and Wayne Krebs scored two goals each for the Bucks while Jerry Hopfe and Rick Benningshof had one each.

The combination of Bill Stankoven and Jerry

Nekrasoff stopped a total of 32 shots in the Kelowna net while the combination of Austin Howe and Ken Bain stopped a total of 23 shots in the Langley net.

Gord Genereux and Greg Norbratten led Nanaimo with two goals each. Dale Ewasiuk, Rod Guimont, Bob Jeffrey and Kim Hilkewich added singles.

For Chilliwack, it was Tom Zelke and Vern Quaroni.

Nanaimo led 3-2 at the end of the first period and 5-2 at the end of the second.

Chilliwack outshot Nanaimo 45-32.

In play tonight, Langley travels to Penticton, Nanaimo goes to Kelowna and Bellingham plays in Chilliwack.
