

Vikings hammer Grand Forks 10-0

Vernon Vikings blasted their farm club, Grand Forks, 10-0 Wednesday in the Border City.

The game was no contest as the older and more experienced Vikings out-played their junior B affiliate in every department.

Meanwhile a goal by Terry Tarnow with 18 seconds remaining gave Langley Lords a 6-5 victory over Nanaimo Clippers in a British Columbia Junior Hockey League game Wednesday.
