## VIKINGS DENY CHANGE COMING

Vernon Vikings' President Les York has denied rumors that some of the club's owners want to get out.

An unconfirmed report Thursday said two or three of the team's six owners were considering selling their shares and leaving the Vikings' organization.

York told the Daily News today he knows of no plans to have an ownership change.

He said, "I have no knowledge of anyone wanting to buy into the club, or anyone wanting to get out for that matter.

"At our meetings we have been discussing general year-end topics and planning for next season.

"As far as I am concerned, we are 100 per cent financially stable."

Reportedly, the team lost more than \$20,000 during the 1974-75 season.

The club owners are York, Ernie Kowal, Nick Schuck, Vern Dye, Pete Pasechnik, and General Manager-Coach Joe Tennant.
