Two directors to leave team

Two of the six directors on the executive of the Vernon Vikings are leaving the organization.

Vikings' President Les York announced this morning that due to business commitments, two of the owners are leaving the team. However, York would not name the pair.

York said, "The remaining directors will be purchasing the available shares, cutting team ownership down to four people."

York and General Manager-coach Joe Tennant had previously made it clear that they intend on remaining with the club. Vern Dye told the Daily News he also plans on staying with the team.

The remaining three owners are Nick Schuck, Ernie Kowal, and Pete Pasechnik.

At an executive meeting Wednesday, the directors tentatively approved a \$90,000 operating budget for next season.
