Vernon players to NHL camps

Two Vernon hockey players are scheduled to leave within the next week for National Hockey League camps.

Kenny Holland will be leaving Friday for Toronto Maple Leafs camp while Eddie Johnstone will be heading out next week for the New York Rangers camp.

Holland, 20, played last season with Medicine Hat Tigers of the Western Canada Hockey League. In 1973-74 he played with Vernon Vikings, and prior to that, Holland played minor hockey in Vernon.

Tigers said they would like to have Holland back this year as an overage player if he cannot come up with an attractive professional offer.

Johnstone started last year with Michigan Stags of the World Hockey Association but
