

Aulin kills Vees with five goals

Kirk Aulin scored five times and Darrell Zelinski added four as Merritt Centennials thumped Penticton Vees 10-4 Tuesday in B.C. Junior Hockey League action in Merritt.

Aulin scored 10 points last season playing with Penticton, but after he was cut this year by Calgary Centennials of the Western Canada Hockey League, the speedy forward ended up in Merritt.

The other Centennials' goals' goal was scored by Dean Chaven.

Captain Gord McKay scored twice for Penticton while Lori Cail and Alan Sidoni added singles.

Randy Struch blocked 34 shots for Merritt, and in the other end Dennis Ewanchuk combined with Rod Wray to turn away 38 shots.

Penticton had 16 of 28 minor penalties and three of four majors.

The win moves Merritt into a second-place tie with Vernon Vikings with 12 points, two behind Kelowna Buckaroos. However, both the Vikings and Bucks have a game-in-hand over the Centennials. Vees trail the Interior Division with seven points.

In the lone game tonight, Chilliwack Bruins travel to Langley.

Vernon is back in action Friday when they travel to Penticton. Saturday, Vikings host Merritt.
