## Speedy winger cut by Vikings

Vernon Vikings released right winger Brad Schultz on Wednesday.

Schultz, 18, scored 21 goals with the Vikings during the 1974-75 season. He started this year with Medicine Hat Tigers and then went to Calgary Centennials, both of the Western Canada Hockey League.

After being released by Calgary, Schultz joined the Vikings two weeks ago. In his stint here, he had no goals and five assists.

Vikings Coach Joe Tennant told the Daily News he just wasn't happy with Schultz's play, particularly defensively.

In the only BCJHL game Wednesday, Grant Wells scored with three seconds remaining to give Langley Lords a 9-8 win over Nanaimo Clippers before 1,200 fans in Nanaimo.

Brian Henderson led Langley with three goals while Mark Taylor added two. Singles went to Del Parker, Terry Lecision, and Ed Lebler.

Brian Day scored three Nanaimo goals and Terry Graff had two. Kim Hillkewich, Greg Norbraten, and Rod Guimont each scored once.

In action tonight, Kelowna is at Merritt. Vikings' next game is Saturday, at home, against Nanaimo.
