

Vees even series with 5-2 triumph

PENTICTON, B.C. (CP) — Gerry Thygeson scored two goals to lead Penticton Vees to a 5-2 triumph over Nanaimo Clippers which evened their 10-point British Columbia Junior Hockey League final at three points each.

John Uvegas, Rob Feenie and Rod Pacholzuk also scored for the Vees in the penalty-filled contest while Terry Graff scored the Clippers' goals in the third period. The Vees led 2-0 after 40 minutes. The first period was scoreless.

Nanaimo coach Larry McNabb pulled his club off the ice for five minutes midway through the game to protest officiating. He refused to discuss his action further with the media after the game ended.

The Clippers took 10 of 19 minors while each club had a pair of majors and split two game misconducts. The Clippers were also assessed a 10-minute misconduct.
