LEFLEY RETURNS TO CLUB

Vernon Vikings' owner Vern Dye announced today big Jack Lefley will be back with the B.C. Junior Hockey League club for the 1976-77 season.

Dye said, "Naturally we're happy Jack is coming back. We're looking for him to provide leadership."

The 195-pound winger came to Vernon midway through the 1974-75 season after being released by Medicine Hat Tigers. Last year he started with Vikings, spent a month with Tigers, and completed the season in Vernon. Lefley was selected to the Interior's all-star squad.

Over the past two years, he became one of the most feared players in the BC-JHL, because of his rugged style.

However, Dye said another 20-year-old veteran he had hoped to have back, may not return.

Dye said Gary Huth, the club's top scorer last season, has indicated he may attend school elsewhere in the province.
