

# Blazers down Flyers in lone BCJHL contest

BELLINGHAM, Wash. (CP) — Martti Nenonen scored his second goal of the game at 5:34 of sudden-death overtime to give Bellingham Blazers a 4-3 win over Abbotsford Flyers in British Columbia Junior Hockey League action Thursday night.

Nenonen fired a slapshot from just over the blueline which beat Abbotsford goalie Larry Lozinski cleanly. Lozinski was not screened on the play, but appeared sur-

prised by the hard shot.

The goal capped a comeback by the Blazers, who trailed 2-0 at the end of the first period, fought back to a 3-2 deficit at the end of two periods, then got the tying goal from Jarf Lindgren midway through the final 20 minutes.

Tekka Makela got the other Bellingham goal, while RVICK Greenwood had two goals and Lindsay Johnson scored the other for Abbotsford.

Lozinski had a strong game in the Abbotsford goal except for his lapse in the overtime, turning aside 33 drives, while Ben Schrey made 26 stops for Bellingham.

Bellingham took eight of 15 minor penalties and Abbotsford had the only major.

In Friday night's action, Vernon Vikings visit Kamloops Braves, Langley Lords play the Buckaroos in Kelowna and Maple Ridge Bruins entertain Penticton Veas.
