

Wills thumps Vikings



Mike Wills has been one of the top snipers in the B.C. Junior Hockey League for two years and he gave notice Friday night he doesn't intend to slow down this season. Wills scored three goals to lead Kelowna Buckaroos to a 6-2 victory over Vernon Vikings before about 1,000 fans at the Kelowna Memorial Arena. The Kellogg Centre won the B.C.H.L. scoring title in 1976-77 and was one of the top scorers in the league during the second-half of last season, after being released by New Westminster Bruins of the W.C.H.L.
