"Our right full-back, Heather Simpson is fast for her position and a very inspirational player."

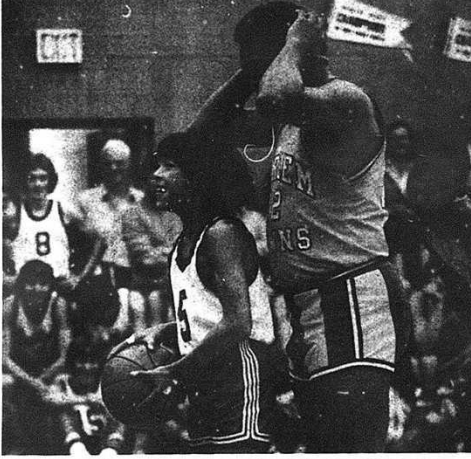
"Judy Campbell is our right-winger and she is aggressive and crosses and passes the ball well."
