# Summerland out of hockey league

The North Okanagan Hockey League will operate with seven teams during the 1979-80 season.

The league had recently expanded to eight teams with the addition of Salmon Arm Aces and Summerland. However, NOHL President Chris Nelson announced today that Summerland will not compete in the league.

Nelson said, "Summerland is having trouble locating a suitable sponsor and management personnel. We gave them every opportunity to enter the league, but we couldn't wait for them any longer. Having seven, instead of eight, teams certainly won't be a hardship."

At a meeting this week the league governors approved a 30-game schedule. All seven teams will make the playoffs with the first-place club getting a bye while the remaining six clubs take part in best-of-three elimination series. Four teams will then advance to the semi-finals.
