**GOALIES' AVERAGES**  
MONTREAL (CP) — If goalkeepers' play is recorded as any indication of what to expect in the National Hockey League semi-finals, Philadelphia Flyers and Buffalo Sabres should meet in the Stanley Cup final.

NHL statistics released Monday showed Philadelphia netminders Phil Myre and Pete Peters with a combined goals-against average of 1.52, a mark they will take into the Spectrum tonight when the Flyers play host to Minnesota North Stars in the series opener.

New York Islanders will face Buffalo's tandem of Don Edwards and Bob Sauve, who have a combined goals-against average of 1.75, second-best in the league, when the teams meet tonight at Buffalo.

IGAs Melocic, whose inspirational play helps lift the North Stars past defending champion Montreal Canadiens, and Gary Edwards, who was solid against Toronto Maple Leafs in preliminary-round action, carry a combined goals-against average of 2.90 against the Flyers.

Buffalo's sharpshooters face Islanders duo of Billy Smith and Glenn Resch, who have a 2.54 combined goals-against record despite Resch's personal 12.00 average.

**CARRIES LOAD**  
Smith leads goaltenders still in the chase with 546 minutes played in nine games, including overtime. He also has the best won-lost record at 7-1. Philadelphia's Myre has the best personal goals-against average at 1.45. Tied for the lead in shutouts with one apiece are Peters, Edwards, Sauve, Smith, Melocic and Michel Larocque of Montreal.

Among scorers, centre Bryan Trottler of the Islanders crept into the top spot with three assists last week against Boston Bruins, giving him 15 points on six goals and nine assists.

Boston centre Peter McNab is second with 14 points, while Minnesota right winger Al MacAdam, Buffalo centre Gilbert Perreault and centre Bobby Smith of the North Stars are tied with 13 points.
