Cents for Lakers in overtime

Paul Hicks scored at 1:36 of sudden-death overtime to give Merritt Centennials a 6-5 win over Vernon Lakers in B.C. Junior Hockey League action Friday, before 400 fans, at the Civic Arena.

Hicks took a perfect pass from Fritz Maier, on a two-on-one break, and beat Vernon goalie Shawn Oswald with a wrist shot to the far side.

NARROWED GAP
Lakers appeared to be in control, late in the third period, with 15 seconds remaining, but the outside of the goal post. Centennials broke quickly out of their end and Guy Lanki was able to get into the clear, behind Wiebe Lanki took a pass from Maier at the Vernon blue line and went in alone on Oswald.

Harvey Makortoff, Allan Wall, and Maier roused out the Merritt scoring.

Hickart replied with three goals for Lakers while Dave Keimer and Derek Waters added singles.

The teams were deadlocked 2-2 at the end of the first period and 3-3 after the second.

Vernon Coach Gord MacBeth was disappointed with his club's performance. "We just didn't have the tip tonight," he said. "I don't think we were up for the game."

Hickart's line, with Richie Oudine and Jeff Armitage on the wings, was by far the most effective for Lakers. Their forechecking continually bottled Merritt up in its own end.

Another bright spot for Vernon was Oswald's performance. The rookie netminder blocked 41 shots, including 17 in the third period. He was sensational during a 58-second span when he kiked out five shots while his club played two men short.

At the other end, Hyreniuk made 31 stops.

"I feel sorry for Shawn," MacBeth said. "The kid was great and we still lost."

Lakers took 12 of 20 minor penalties.

STRIKING OUT
Vernon was without defenceman Gary Shilling and newcomer Regan Desroches. Shilling is ineligible until his birth certificate arrives from Edmonton and Desroches is awaiting his release from Nanaimo.

Lakers return to the ice tonight, in Kelowna, against the Buckaroos.
