BEST TIME OF DAY

Cowichan Valley now leads the best-of-seven quarter-final series 2-1.

In leading the Capitals with two goals each were Dean Bell, Guyle Cimet and Darryl Wavryk. Singles went to Dave Brantling, Len Meyer, Marty Irvine and Dan Hodgson.

Scoring for Abbotsford were Colin Lunenburg, Mike Moore, Bob Brown, Don Yewchin, Tom Weiss and Rene Ven-Abbotsford led 2-1 after one period and 5-2 after two. Abbotsford's Ken Baker and Scott Dradley stopped a total of 23 shots. Cowichan Valley's Ken Trossell and Darryl Reaugh blocked 66.

Rangers still train Flyers by two points

If the Rangers are right, he and the rest of his New York Rangers teammates and Philadelphia Flyers can expect to get to know each other pretty well in the next month or so.

The Rangers and Flyers battled to a 4-4 National Hockey League tie Thursday night, keeping New York two points ahead of Philadelphia in the second round of the Patrick Division.

The teams play each other three more times before the regular season ends and they return to meet again in the first round of the playoffs. The second-place team will have the home-ice advantage in a best-of-five series against the third-place finisher.

"It was the chipiest game I've been in all year," said Dugan of the Thursday game. "There were a lot of grabs and hooks and high sticks."

The tie, created when New York's Andre Duro scored his fourth goal of the season with a little more than two minutes to go, tied the Rangers and the Flyers at 4-4.

'ALL GAMES CLOSE'
All the games between the Flyers and the Rangers closed close, the said New York coach Herb Brooks. "A bounce of the puck there and there will deter-

mine the outcome. "It gives us confidence that we can come back like this."

Meanwhile, Philadelphia coach Pat Quinn lamented breakdowns that led to New York's tying goal.

"The tying goal was just a no-brainer on our part," Quinn bemoaned. "Unfortunately, when we didn't have the puck, we played pretty darn well."

When he had the puck, we made a couple of good plays. Darryl Stiller scored twice for the Flyers. His goal in the first minute of the second period gave Philadelphia a 2-2 tie and his third-period goal offset a short-handed effort by New York's Mark Pavelich, making it 3-2 at 8:31.

Less than a minute later, Brian Propp scored to give the Flyers a 3-2 lead.

Ed Hopyard slaked the Rangers' thirst for victory when he beat goaltender Pelle Lindbergh, recalled Wednesday by the Flyers from the American Hockey League.

SCORES ON BREAKAWAY
Bill Barber tied it at 13:15 of the second period, before New York's Mike Leino scored three minutes later on a breakaway pass from Rob McManahan.

In the only other game, New York Islanders buried Toronto Maple Leafs 10-1 to extend their unbeaten streak at Nassau Coliseum to 17 games.

Mike Bossy became the third player this season to get 50 goals, scoring three times to lift his total to 51.

It was the fifth season in a row the Montreal native has scored 50 or more goals, only the fourth player in league history to 73-75 in the Norris Division, six goals behind fourth-place Chicago Black Hawks.

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Giants, Tigers swap veterans

New Champ Summers feels wanted.

"The Giants gave up two players to get me, so that looks good," Summers said after he was traded Thursday from Detroit Tigers to San Francisco.

"I just want me. I haven't wanted to anyone out there yet, but evidently they wanted me and there might be a spot for me," he said.

Summers, unhappy with his role as a left-handed designated hitter, got his shot when the Tigers dealt him away for infielder Enos Cabell and a player to be named later.

Summers, 33, batted 25 with three homers and 21 runs batted in last year. A well-travelled veteran who has played with four major league teams, the pitcher is a lifetime .262 bat in nine years.

The Tigers also made another deal Thursday, acquiring two young players, infielder Jeff Cox and catcher Scott Meyer, in exchange for three minor leaguers.

The 26-year-old Danville, Va., outfielder had hit 270 in Triple A last year and pitched seven games in the majors.

Meanwhile, Fernando Valenzuela remains a hotbed active player.
