Eagles dip Bluehawks

Stachoski made 33 saves in Burnaby net.

The Rockets got goals from Harvey Bougerolle, Wade Waters, Gordon Young, Bruce Baker and Rob Crawford.

The Totems pulled out to an early 2-0 lead at the end of the first and increased their lead to 6-3 at the end of the second.

All four goaltenders saw action. Jim Young and Roy Drohobycki combined to make 27 saves for Revelstoke, while Roy Hankin and Rob Filler kicked aside 33 for the Totems.
