

Flyers win game and final series

ABBOTSFORD, B.C. (CP) — Abbotsford Flyers edged by Kelowna Buckaroos 3-2 Monday to win their best-of-seven B.C. Junior Hockey League championship series 4-1.

The Flyers got two goals from Collin Meissner and a single from Bill Shibicky, the league's leading scorer in both the regular season and the playoffs.

Abbotsford took the lead in the first period and never looked back with period scores of 1-0 and 2-1.

Flyers' owner Harvey Unger said his team won because of discipline.
