

SCORING STATISTICS

Wensley is flying

If there was any doubt that this year's edition of the Vernon Lakers Junior Hockey Team is improved over last year's stock, those doubts will certainly vanish with the latest scoring statistics released by the club.

Team scoring leader Dave Wensley still fronts the local pack and has already amassed a point total equal to that of Stacy Wakabayashi, who led the team last season.

Wensley has 31 goals and 46 assists, in 34 games, for 77 points. He has just 56 penalty minutes and leads the team in the plus-minus department with a whopping plus-41.

Meanwhile, 20-year-old defenceman Ken MacKenzie is scoring, something he did only occasionally as a 19-year-old in the BCJHL. MacKenzie is second in team scoring with 12 goals and a team-leading 48 assists for 60 points and second spot.

MacKenzie earned just 19 points last season and with 26 games remaining could break the league record for scoring by a defenceman.

Among the other team members who have greatly improved over last season are forwards Nick Kapicki

and Greg Kowal.

Kapicki, with 17 goals and 26 assists for 43 points, has already equalled his point production from last season while Kowal with 10 goals and 18 assists, for 28 points, has doubled his production from last season.
