

Lakers boast potent offence

In terms of individual statistics, the 1983-84 version of Vernon Lakers rank among the all-time best teams this city has produced.

Statistics released this week by Lakers' management show seven players with 20 goals or better, two with 19, one with 18 and an 11th player with 15.

Dave Wensley, though sidelined for the past two weeks is tied for first place with 38 goals and 49 assists for 87 points. Defenceman Ken MacKenzie has now caught Wensley with 21 goals and 66 assists for 87 points.

MacKenzie, now favored to place at the top of the heap for Vernon scorers, is fast closing on the BCJHL record for scoring by a defenceman at 100 points, set by Penticton's Bruce Affleck during the 1971-72 season.

A big plus for the team has been the spirited play of Scott Young who has contributed 31 goals, 37 assists and 68 points in just 36 games.
