

Langley defeats Knights

LANGLEY, B.C. (CP) — Paul Lelievre's goal early in the third period Tuesday night gave Langley Eagles a 4-3 victory over Penticton Knights in the first game of their best-of-seven B.C. Junior Hockey League championship series.

The teams meet here again tonight.

Penticton led 2-1 at the end of the first period but Langley led 3-2 early in the second before Brett Hull scored at 8:49 to tie the game.

Lelievre's goal at 3:50 of the third stood up for the win.

Neil Reimer, Phil Stanger and Pat Barnes scored the other Langley goals.

Hull had two goals, and Ian Kidd added a single for the Knights.
