

Note: "This would mean there are only three face off spots on the ice, one at centre ice and one at each blue line." This does not affect the face off spots in the circle by each goal at each end of the rink...



How Come It's Called A "Puck"?

In 1885, Queen's University and the Royal Military College played Canada's first organized hockey game, and "the original puck" is today on display in Queen's Gym. It is a sawed-up lacrosse ball and looks homemade. Yet the official puck of the NHL, for all its vulcanized rubber material and standardized diameter of three inches, as well as its one-inch thickness, retains a touch of informality and may vary as much as half an ounce in weight.

All of this fits in with the name, puck. Just how it came to be called that, or by whom, nobody knows. But it was aptly named—Webster defines "puck" as "a mischievous

sprite or elf."
