 Brett Hull scored 105 goals and 188 points in 1983 - 84 while playing for the Penticton Knights, both totals are BCJHL League records.

- BCJHL Teams have won 5 of the last 11 Centennial Cup (National) Championships. (1986 Penticton Knights, 1987 Richmond Sockeyes, 1990 & 1991 Vernon Lakers, 1993 Kelowna Spartans)

- The Kelowna Spartans were just 49 seconds from winning the 1994 Centennial Cup when the Olds Grizzly's scored to tie the game at 4. Olds went on to win in overtime when the Spartans scored an own goal.

- The Vernon Lakers are the only Junior 'A' team to attend 4 straight Centennial Cup Tournaments.

Veteran PGA (Professional Golfers Association) Dave Barr played defence for the Kelowna Buckaroos in the 1969-70 season before attending Brigham-Young University on a golf scholarship.

- BCJHL Teams have won 10 of the last 13 Doyle Cup (BC/Alberta) Championships.

- BCJHL Teams have won the last 16 straight Mowat Cup (Provincial) Championships including 15 straight over the Rocky Mountain Junior Hockey League (previously the Peace-Cariboo Junior Hockey League), in fact the BCJHL have won 36 straight games in the Mowat Cup.

- The BCJHL first ever scoring champion Jackie James is a practicing lawyer in Vancouver.

- 1972-73 League scoring champion Chad Campbell was a member of award winning rock group "Idle Eyes".

 Winning Jet Dallas Drake won the 1987-88 BCJHL League scoring championship while playing for the Vernon Lakers.

- Grant Evans (Kamloops '68) and Joe Murphy (Penticton '85) shared the BCJHL record of 7 goals in a single game.

 Powell River players have won 3 of the last 4 Coastal Rookie of the Year Awards. (Jay McNeill 91, Robb Gordon 93 & Cal Elfring 94).

GREATER VERNON MULTI-USE ARENA AND ENTERTAINMENT CENTRE

On October 28, 1995 the voters in the Greater Vernon area will be asked to vote in a referendum for a \$16 million multi-use arena and entertainment centre.

The multi-use arena and entertainment centre proposed for Greater Vernon will be located along 43rd Avenue, just east of Kin Race Track, behind the Vernon Square shopping centre. The building will have an initial seating capacity of 4,000 seats, expandable to 6,200 by adding a balcony (inside the existing building). The seats will be moulded plastic theatre style seats. The ice surface will be NHL size, but expandable to an Olympic size surface. There will be a large concourse above the seats, washrooms, change rooms, and concession, all with central heating and air conditioning.

The new facility will provide the additional icetime required for children and adult activities and it will eliminate the waiting list for ice users. Due to the ability to remove (and reinstall) the ice quickly, the facility will be able to accommodate many other uses. For example concerts by Rita McNeal or Gordon Lightfoot and many others will be able to make good use of the facility because it will have a seating capacity for concerts initially with 5,500 and later up to 7,500 people. This number of seats will depend on the concert arrangement, centre-stage, side-stage or end-stage set up. It will be equipped with a superior electronically enhanced sound system and the building will be constructed with acoustically treated roof panels.

Beside concerts, the facility will be able to handle rodeos, circuses, boxing events, wrestling, large meetings (political/religious), dances, bazaars, indoor soccer, equestrian events, dirt bikes, auctions, vehicle shows, craft fairs (55,000 sq. feet of exhibition space) and last but not least large conventions. Some of the seating will be removable to accommodate all these different floor activities.

The construction cost of the facility will be \$16 million and to borrow this amount plus the annual operating deficit will have the following effect on the taxpayer:

The annual impact on the average home owners taxes is as follows:

The difference in cost for an average house in each area is a result of the value of the homes being higher in some areas, plus some areas have a higher portion of industrial commercial tax base. As the populations in the area grows this annual cost will decrease. The debt will be amortized over a 20 year period.




