Prospect Game

Play the game of their lives and get noticed by a college scout. That's the basic goal of the 40 players in the inaugural B.C. Hockey League Prospects game Wednesday night at the multiplex.

The Vipers will be represented by head coach Mike Vandekamp, goalie Matt Zaba, centre Brent Kisio and defenceman Jake Wilkens (in place of injured Andrew Derton) on Team Chevrolet.

"Of course you'd like to put up some numbers, but it's going to be a lot more intense than the usual all-star game," said Kisio, a Calgary product who's been known to stir a pot or two.

"You're going to have to work your bag off and it should be pretty physical. You want to show scouts you have the whole package and are willing to compete. That suits my style and it will be much better for the fans."

The biggest beneficiaries of the switch from the usual pond-hockey gala to the Prospects format will be the goaltenders, who in past years have been shelled by the league's premiere snipers.

"I'm not a big fan of the shootout games they used to have," said Zaba, the league's top tender with a 2.32 GAA and 92.8 save percentage. "Everyone is going to want to show scouts they can play at both ends in this game, so there shouldn't be as many defensive breakdowns or odd-man rushes. It's good for the goaltenders, but it will still give us a chance to show the scouts what we can do."

Zaba, obtained in an early September trade with the Penticton Panthers, will be joined by fellow star net detective Jocelyn Guimond of the Williams Lake TimberWolves.

And while the plethora of NCAA scouts will increase the anxiety level prior to the showcase, Merritt Centennials' workhorse JasonDupuis is looking forward to the all-star atmosphere.

"It's a chance to have some fun against the best players in the league," said Dupuis, who will backstop team Labatt Blue along with Blair Robertson of the Quesnel Millionaires. "It's not going to be the usual wide-open all-star game just because there's a lot on the line. There's going to be a ton of scouts and it will be a chance to show what you can do against guys who are also competing for scholarships."

The Blues will look to Powell River Kings' stud Mike DiStefano (27-45-72) and Mike Hamilton of the Cents (30-39-69) for prime-time offence Wednesday night.

Grant Selinger of the South Surrey Eagles (20-45-65) and Clayton Lainsbury of the Prince George Spruce Kings will pump up the Chevys' attack.



The BCHL is committed to providing players the greatest possible competition, opportunity, development (talent, character and education), and exposure, in order that they are best able to achieve long term success on an athletic, personal and academic level.

TRADITION OF SUCCESS

The BCHL is proud of its 41 year history of success. League teams have dominated the BC Junior "A" Provincial Championships and have defeated the Alberta Junior "A" champion for the Doyle Cup in 15 of the past 20 seasons.

In addition, a BCHL team has been crowned the Canadian National Junior "A" Champion (Royal Bank Cup) in eight of the past 16 years including the Vernon Vipers in 1999, while on three other occasions a BCHL team has advanced to the championship final.

EXPOSURE, VISIBILTY AND ACHIEVEMENT

The sixteen BCHL teams collectively drew over 600,000 fans during the 2001-02 season. This season sees an expansion of the league into Williams Lake and the transfer of Burnaby to Port Alberni. Local newspaper coverage is extensive, and helps to maintain Junior "A" hockey as the highest profile sport in each of the respective communities. Several teams also enjoy local radio and television coverage, with scheduled live broadcasts of both home and away games.

BCHL games are regularly attended by US College, Major Junior, Canadian University and NHL scouts. Weekly and monthly league statistical packages are distributed to more than 75 teams and leagues throughout Canada and the USA, and the NHL. Central Scouting routinely lists BCHL players as Entry Draft prospects. In fact, four BCHL players were drafted in each of the 199, 2000 & 2002 Entry Drafts and five in the 2001 Entry Draft, each year, more than any other Junior "A" league in Canada. In addition, each year the league produces a professional Media Guide which includes the league records, player profiles, and statistical summary to ensure local media outlets and scouts have all necessary information on league players at their disposal. The league web site collects nearly ¾ of a million visitors annually.

This kind of exposure has helped the BCHL gain a well earned reputation as a source of quality talent. Former BCHL players can be found at virtually every level of hockey, including the NHL, all of the various minor pro leagues in both North America and Europe, the CHL and the CIAU. In fact, 375 Canadian born

players were playing US College Division I hockey, more than 30% are BCHL graduates (122 players) – by far the most from any of the ten Junior "A" leagues in Canada.

But numbers alone do not tell the whole story – BCHL graduates are also routinely recognized for their athletic and academic achievement. Jason Krog (1998-99), Brendan Morison (1996-97) and Paul Kariya (1992-93) have all received the Hobey Baker Memorial Award, presented annually to the most outstanding US College hockey player, and in five of the past nine seasons "The Hockey News" has named a former BCHL player as its US College Hockey Player of the Year. In addition, each year BCHL grads can be found leading their teams in scoring, or winning a US College Hockey award such as Most Valuable Player, League All Star or Academic All American.

EDUCATION

The BCHL is understandably proud of those graduates who have played in the NHL, however, it is equally proud of the literally hundreds of players who hve gone on to obtain a US College degree, and the many others who have obtained a Canadian University degree. Over the past decade, more players from the BCVHL have received a "full-ride" US College Hockey scholarship or Ivy League financial aid package, than from any other Junior "A" league in Canada. Individuals such as Bob Nicholson, Canadian Hockey Association President and Dave Norris, former NHL Operations Manager and now Assistant General Manager for the Vancouver Canucks are but two of the hundreds of players who have taken advantage of the educational opportunities presented to them through the BCHL.

OPPORTUNITY

Unlike most of the other Junior "A" leagues in North America, the BCHL does not utilize a "protected list". Players entering the league for the first time are free to choose which of the seventeen league teams they wish to play for. In turn, league teams compete to provide the best possible program in order to attract the most talented players. This results in a wider range of viable options for players, and is one of the main reasons the BCHL is considered by US College scouts to be the most competitive Junior "A" leagues in North America.

Furthermore, each BCHL team is limited to a maximum of six 20 year old players on their roster, which provides younger players with both increased roster opportunities and ice time. League regulations also limit team rosters to 21 players per team this means maximum playing time for all carded players.

BCHL teams cover the cost of all room and board (billeting), equipment and travel expenses (buses, hotels, meals, etc.). Players are required to pay only a league registration fee of \$420.


PRESENCE IN THE PROS




